Road Construction: County Roads to be Resurfaced

The Logan County Engineer's Office announces that the Shelly Company will be working on the following roads.

These roads will be under construction between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. each day, but will remain open to emergency vehicles and local traffic only (no thru traffic).

Butt joints are cut at the intersections and bridges prior to paving and create a bump in the roadway, please slow down accordingly (15 mph or less).

During these operations, emergency and local traffic will be maintained using flagging personnel. No thru traffic will be permitted. Motorists should anticipate delays and are encouraged to plan alternate routes.

When traveling through these work areas, we ask all drivers to **slow down and use extra caution**. Please note that these areas will have **unmarked no-passing zones until fall**.

For optimal safety and to help the resurfacing cure effectively, motorists are encouraged to travel a maximum of 20 mph on the first day the chip seal has been applied and to travel a maximum of 30 mph for at least seven days after the chip seal has been applied.
