The Logan County Engineer's Office plans to purchase approximately 280,000 gallons of high float rapid setting polymer modified anionic asphalt emulsion (HFRS-2P) for use in its 2020 chip seal program.

The bidder shall indicate on the bid form the type of polymer modifier (such as SBS, SBR) that is being bid. Failure to specify the modifier may result in the bid being rejected.

Fog Seal MATERIAL

The Logan County Engineer's Office plans to purchase approximately 42,500 gallons of quick breaking fog seal asphalt emulsion for use in its 2020 roadway maintenance operations.

The fog seal product (if approved) shall be supplied conforming to specification in this document. If requested product verification test results shall be provided prior to application.

MWS-90 MATERIAL

The Logan County Engineer's Office plans to purchase approximately 10,000 gallons of anionic medium to high setting asphalt emulsion for use in its 2020 roadway maintenance operations.

MWS-90 shall be supplied conforming to The Ohio DOT required specification.
