


BEDDOW ADDITION

lots from 22625 inclusive are subdivision of a block 127 feet south 15 poles east and 118 poles north each lot being 62 1/2 feet and with lines parallel to Water Street — The lots above represented are part of the N.E. qr. of Sec. 34 T4, N.R. 5. Survey commenced at a stone planted at corner S.W. Corner and N.W. Corner of Water St. Water St. is S 89° E and 60 feet wide South alley is also S 89° E. 15 feet wide Grove alleys are at right angles with Water St. and 16 1/2 feet wide lots No 1-7 were laid out by O. Hopkins Sec 20th 1848 and are 100 ft front by 200 feet S 86 from 9 1/2 21 are 50 ft front by 247 feet deep and Platted Dec 1, 1849. State of Ohio, County of Logan.

Before me James Timmer personally appeared Thaddeus Bedow and Hannah Bedow his wife and acknowledged the foregoing plat and subdividing of the town lots above represented in the above plat to be their voluntary act and deed for the purpose there in set forth and in compliance with law in such case made and provided for testimony where of they have here unto set their hand and seals the day and year above written.

lots are laid on a true line N 14° E. Corresponding to the old town street and alleys are parallel to or a right angle with line lots No 1-2-3 and 4 are 55 feet front by 220 feet S 86 no 5 is 55 feet N 53 1/2° E and 100 ft North alley is 10 feet wide Stone planted at the South East corner of lot No 5 10 feet wide West of Stone marked with a diagonal line is a side-walk Madison Street and the alley returned out of the old town retains their width and course surveyed and platted April 24 and 29th 1850
State of Ohio Logan County ss.
Before me a Justice of the Peace within and for said County personally came Benjamin Stanton and Nancy his wife of the County of Logan and State of Ohio and acknowledge the annexed plat and survey of the Northern Addition to Bellefontaine to be their voluntary act and deed for the purpose there in set forth and hereby dedicate the streets and alleys there in set forth to the public as public streets and highways and the said Nancy having being examined by me separately and apart her said husband and the said plat and survey having being explained and there after made known to her by me she acknowledged the same to be her act and deed and relinquishes all right of dower therein and that she is still satisfied therewith
