The undersigned Surveyor do hereby Certify that the annexed Plat is a correct representation of Powell's 5th Addition to Bellefontaine Ohio as surveyed and laid out by me on the 7th to 11th days of March A.D. 1892, and that the following is a true and accurate description of the same, Main Street bears Magnetic N. 6.00 E. Detroit and Henry Streets are parallel to it. Williams St. and Powell Avenue are at right angles to it except on Powell Avenue from Detroit to Main where the South side of the Avenue bears South from a right angle and the North side forms a continuous line from Main Street to terminus. One half of Henry Street 30 feet wide Detroit is continued 60 feet wide, Williams Street is continued 60 feet wide to intersect Elm St. as monumented in the Gardner Addition. Powell Avenue is continued 50 feet wide to Powell's West line, and widened on the North line from Detroit to Main Street in order to straighten the line. All Alleys are parallel with or at right angles to Main Street. All distances on the 5th Addition marked in feet and hundredths, on the abutting property in same order as found on the records of same. All intersections of Streets, and street lines with property lines marked with stone monuments as shown by the circles on the annexed Plat. The angles which all marked lines make with each other is marked on the annexed Plat at the point of intersection. Intermediate distances marked on with black ink, complete distances from center to center marked on with brown or red ink Lots 1533, 1546, 1546, 1547, 1548, and 1549 have already been conveyed as fractions of land and are as given on the annexed Plat.

Surveyor Certificate. The above Plat Represents 77 town lots and the Streets and Alleys laid out for their benefit and convenience together with the connection of same with the adjoining Streets and lands, all being parts of Original Military Survey No. 4990, in the town of Bellefontaine, in the County of Logan, State of Ohio as Surveyed and stated out by the undersigned Surveyor in April A.D. 1891, at the request and under the direction of Frank Stanton, Charles D. 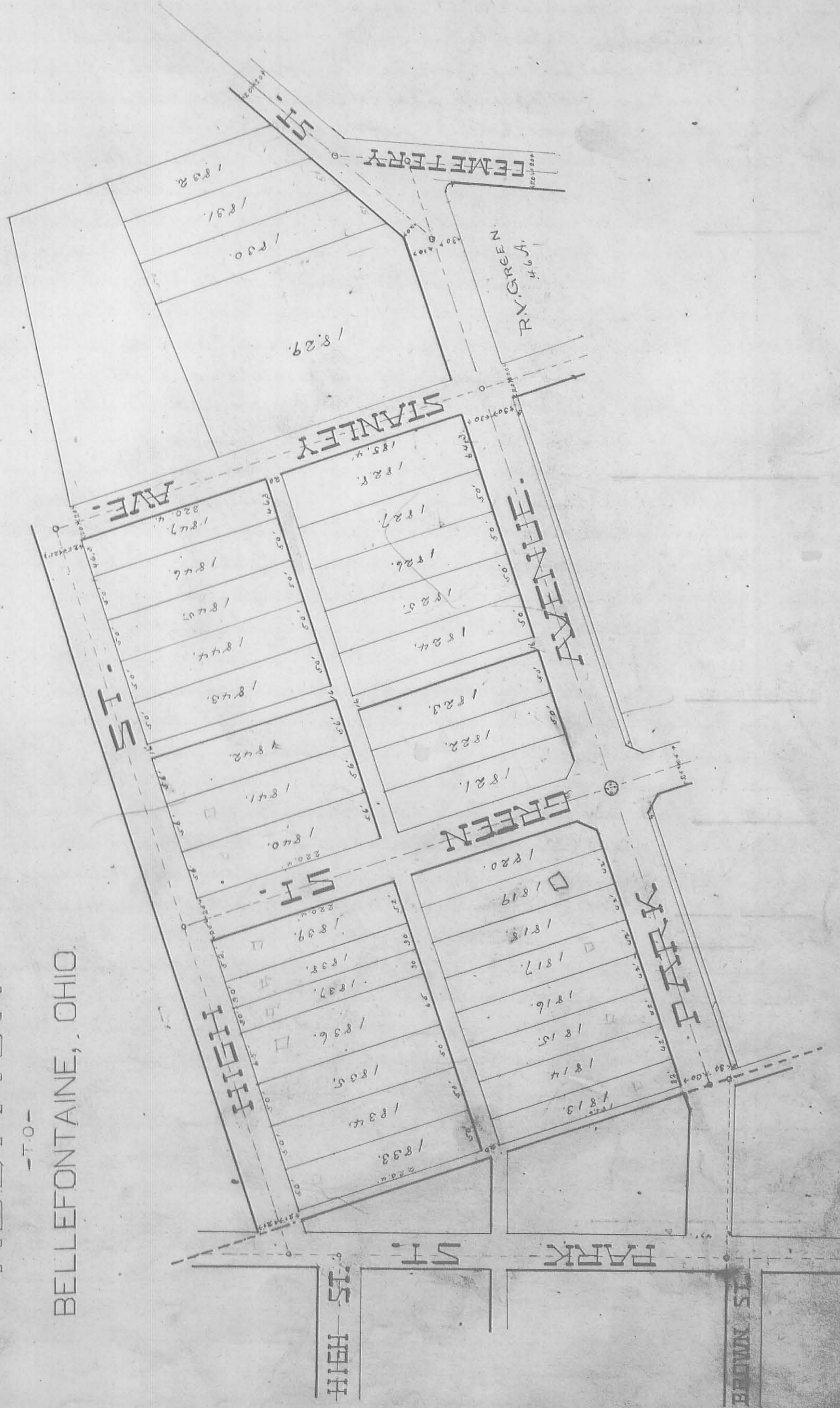


