

Balance of Hurley land-

A parcel of land in the City of Bellefontaine, Lake Township, Logan County, Ohio, and being a part of the Original V.M.S. 5245, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the most Northerly ~~point~~ corner of Lot No. 3592 of Indian Parks Addition No. 5-

Thence S.  $44^{\circ}51'$  E., along the Easterly line of said Lot No. 3592, a distance of nineteen (19) feet to a point-

Thence N.  $85^{\circ}21'$  E., a distance of one hundred sixty-nine and  $1/10$  (169.1) feet, to a point on the centerline of Allison Road (formerly known as the Cemetary Pike)-

Thence N.  $5^{\circ}39'$  W., along the said centerline of Allison Road, a distance of one hundred eighteen and  $6/10$  (118.6) feet to a point which is the intersection of the Southerly line of Park Road extended to the centerline of said Allison Road-

Thence S.  $72^{\circ}16'$  W., along the Southerly line of said Park Road, a distance of two hundred and  $7/10$  (200.7) feet to a point-

Thence S.  $23^{\circ}26'$  E., a distance of forty-nine and  $25/100$  (49.25) feet, to the point of beginning-

Containing  $36/100$  (0.36) acres of land, be the same more or less, but subject to all legal highway use.

Said parcel being a part of that land conveyed to Paul E. and Anabelle J. Hurley as noted in Volume 203, Page 513, of the deed records of Logan County.
