



Surveyed on the 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup> of March A.D. 1857, as represented by the above plat, the North West Quarter of Section No. 13 of Town No. 2, & Range 15 E., N. R., 1<sup>st</sup> <sup>Logan Co. O.</sup> for Dennis Moore & the County of Logan as follows:

Dennis Moore's }  
 Land } Beginning at a stone in the "Indian Boundary Line", at the North West corner of said section, from which a Tree White Oak 20 in diam. bears S. 47° E. 20 links marked "13, 2, 15" and described as an original witness tree, thence run with said "Indian Boundary Line" N. 80 1/2 E. 33, 50/100 chains to a stake of 12 in diam. N. 76° E. 26 links, Original witness; thence S. 86 3/4 E. 8, 18/100 chains to a stone which I planted between the roots of a tree which had fallen, & described in the original field notes as a 'corner tree' (Witness; a Pidgeon oak 5 in diam N. 7° E. 21 links & Hickory 16 in diam S. 86° E. 25 links; thence S. 1° W. 28 1/2

chain to a stone & brick bats in the county road leading from Bellefontaine to Lewis town; thence with the middle of said road N. 71 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 12,  $\frac{81}{100}$  chains to a stone & brick bats; thence S. 1° W. 17,  $\frac{67}{100}$  chains to a stone & brick bats, & a  $\frac{28}{100}$  chains to a stone & brick bats in the west line of said section & the S.W. corner to the said N. West quarter; thence with the west section line N. 1° E. 34,  $\frac{04}{100}$  chains to the place of Beginning containing One Hundred thirty seven and four tenth acres (137.4 acres)

County Land } Beginning at a stone and brick bats in the centre of the section, at the centre corner, from which a white oak 22 in diam bears S. 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 8 links, thence run N. 89° W. 12,  $\frac{28}{100}$  chains to a stone & brick bats at the ~~corner~~ S. E. corner of Lewis Moore Land (W. T. W. oak 20 in diam. S. 60 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° E. 9 links; D. 26 in diam. S. 80 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W. N. thence N. 1° E. 15,  $\frac{67}{100}$  chains to a stone & brick bats in the centre of the county Road leading from Bellefontaine to Lewis town; thence S. 71 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E with the centre of the road 12,  $\frac{81}{100}$  to a stone and brick bats near a culvert in the Road; thence South 1° W. 12,  $\frac{03}{100}$  chains to the place of Beginning containing Seventeen (17) acres
