

Sneeden - Stratton Survey Jefferson Twp. August 1954 1.26 Acres

The following described land in Jefferson Township, Logan County Ohio, and being in V.M.S. 3137 The 1.26 acres described being off of the east end of the present 8.25 acre tract in the name of Ina L. Sneeden.

Beginning at a small iron in the center of County Road Number ten known as the Bristle Ridge Road at the N.W. corner of Dorotha Ruth Strayer's 10.67 acre tract and said beginning point also being station 244 plus 69 of said Road Number ten as shown in Logan County Engineer's Survey Book Number 615 page 26 thence with the west side of said Strayer land S. 19 - 14 W. 313.0 feet to a large wood post at the S.W. corner of said Strayer land thence with the west line of Jas. Van Hyning's 75.20 acre tract S. 19 - 38 W. 158.0 feet to a large wood post at an interior corner of said Van Hyning land thence with a north line of said Van Hyning land N. 69 - 03 W. 122.0 feet to an iron pipe thence N. 19 - 14 E. 417.0 feet to an iron in the center of Road Number ten thence with the center line of Road Number ten N. 87 - 38 E. 132.3 feet to the place of beginning said tract containing 1.26 acres.
