

Shoots Survey Jefferson Township August 1964 2.88 Acres.

The following described land in Jefferson Township, Logan County, Ohio, and being in V.M.S. 3138.

Beginning at an iron in the center of County Road Number 5 also known as the West Liberty - Rushsylvania Pike and said beginning point being station 363 plus 84.10 of the road survey as shown on Logan County Engineer's Plan of said Road Number 5 and also being the S.W. corner of a 1.86 acre tract now in the name of Jacob R. Baker.

Thence with the south line of said Baker 1.86 acre tract N. 45° - $36'$ W. 261.00 feet to a square wood post at the N.W. corner of said Baker tract.

Thence S. 48° - $10'$ W. 171.00 feet to an iron.

Thence S. 46° - $57'$ W. 270.50 feet to an iron.

The last two described lines being the fence line of the now abandoned T. & O.C. Railroad Right of way.

Thence S. 63° - $58'$ E. 412.50 feet to an iron in the center of County Road Number 5.

Thence with the center line of said County Road Number 5 N. 25° - $16'$ E. 328.50 feet to the place of beginning.

The above described tract contains 2.88 acres.
