

DESCRIPTION OF
HEMPHILL ESTATES INC. TRACT
Sec. 26, T-4, R-14
Liberty Township

The following described real estate situated in Liberty Township, Logan County, Ohio and being part of Fractional Section 26, Town 4, Range 14 of the Between the Miami Rivers Survey and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of County Highway No. 1 (Ludlow Road) at the Southeast corner of Raymond L. Thompson's 50.15 acre tract, said iron pin being Sta. 263+65 as shown on page 20 of the Logan County Engineer's field book No. 598; thence with the center line of said County Highway No. 1 S. 13°-00' E. 53.2 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 83°-05' W. 297.8 feet to an iron pin; thence parallel with and 280.0 feet perpendicularly west of the center line of said County Highway No. 1 S. 13°-00' E. 1619.5 feet to a stake in the north line of Paul M. Earley's 82.00 acre tract; thence with said Earley's north line N. 83°-23' W. 2850.0 feet to a stone at the southeast corner of Katherine S. Sapp's 28.55 acre tract; thence with said Sapp's east line and the east line of Margaret L. Scott's 28.16 acre tract N. 1°-00' W. 1605.8 feet to a stone at the northeast corner of said Scott's tract and the southwest corner of said R. L. Thompson's 50.15 acre tract; thence with said Thompson's south line S. 83°-05' E. 2803.0 feet to the place of beginning.
