

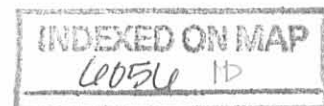

The following described real estate situated in Miami Township, Logan County, Ohio and being part of the southwest quarter of Section 17, Town 3, Range 13 of the Between the Miami Rivers Survey and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a stone in the center of Township Road No. 71 at the northeast corner of said southwest quarter section as shown in Logan County Engineer's Field Book 608, page 69; thence with the centerline of said T.R.71 N.83°05'W. 218.8 feet to a railroad spike, said railroad spike being the beginning point of this description; thence continuing with the centerline of said T.R.71 N.83°05'W. 381.0 feet to a stone at the northeast corner of Harold C. Eicher's 73.23 acre tract; thence continuing with the centerline of said T.R.71 S.7°17'W. 404.6 feet to a railroad spike; thence S.84°11'E. 383.6 feet to an iron corner post; thence N.6°55'E. 397.2 feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 3.52 acres more or less.

The above described tract being part of Richard H. Glett's 17.77 acre tract.
