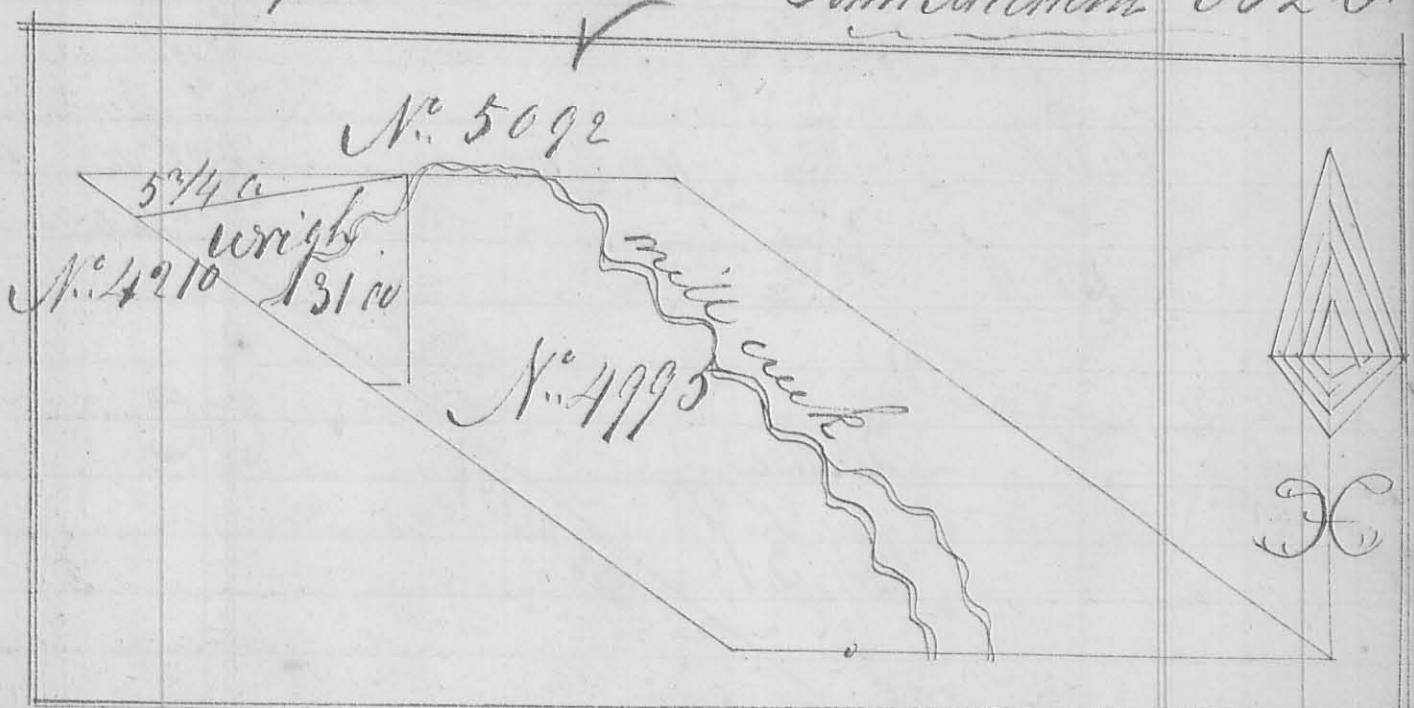

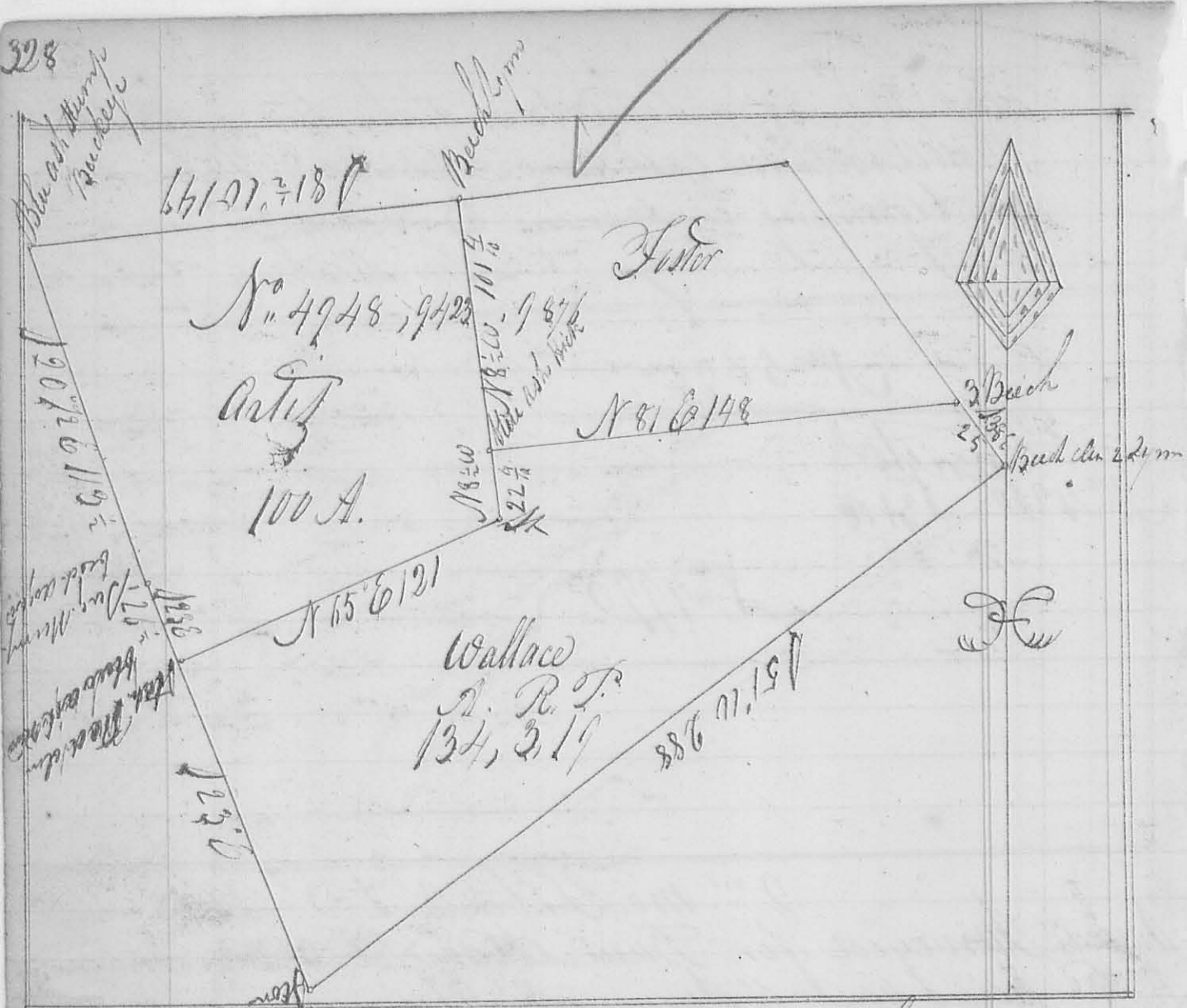

 No. 4948, 9423, 9876, the 1<sup>st</sup> tract, beg. at a  
 Blue ash stump & Buckeye, S. W.  $\angle$  to Thomas Hotta  
 Survey No. 2674: thence S 20° E 113 $\frac{1}{2}$  poles, crossing a  
 small branch, to Sugar stump, Beech & Dogwood (the beech  
 is dead) cor. to S. Gickens: thence with said line S 25° E to  
 a Stake red Elm N 12° W 19 links, Blue ash & Cornwood:  
 thence N 65° E 121 poles to a Stake: thence N 81° W 101 $\frac{1}{2}$   
 poles, passing R. Blackleys S. W. cor. at 22 $\frac{1}{2}$  poles  
 & crossing a branch at 88 poles, to a beech & L<sup>r</sup> in the  
 South line of said Hotta said Survey No. 2674 N. W. Cor.
