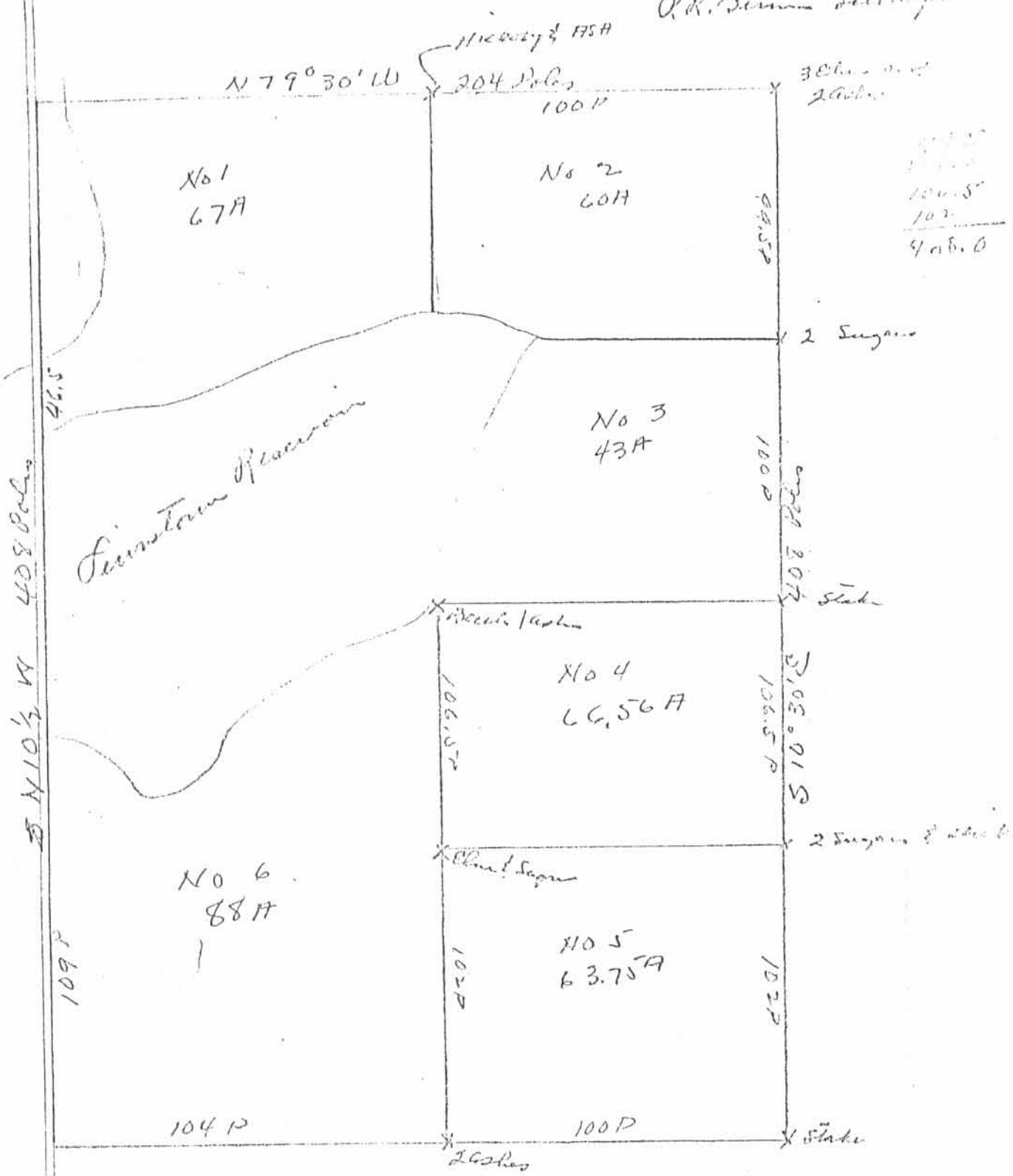

Lewistown Reservoir. Established in 1875.

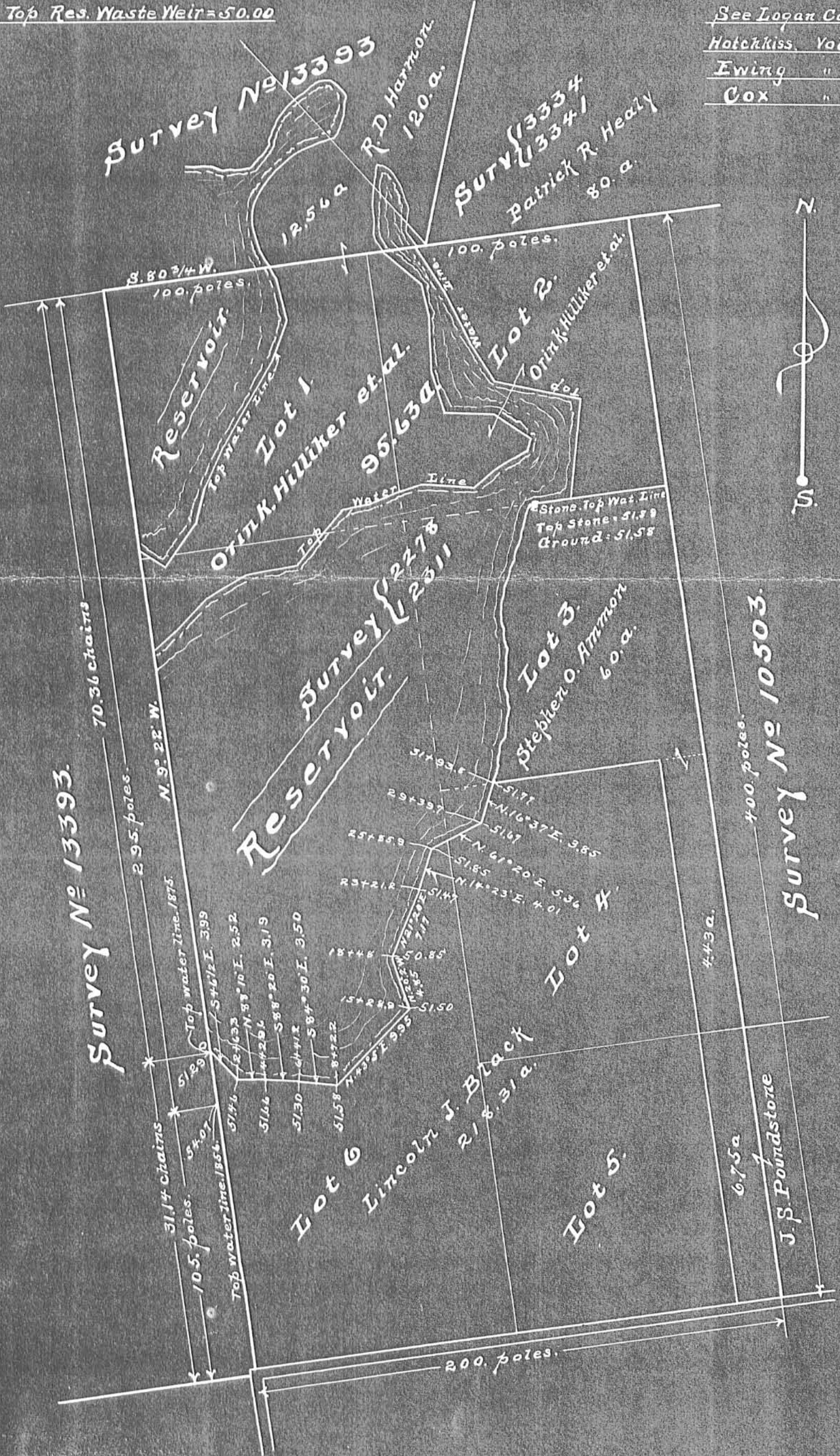

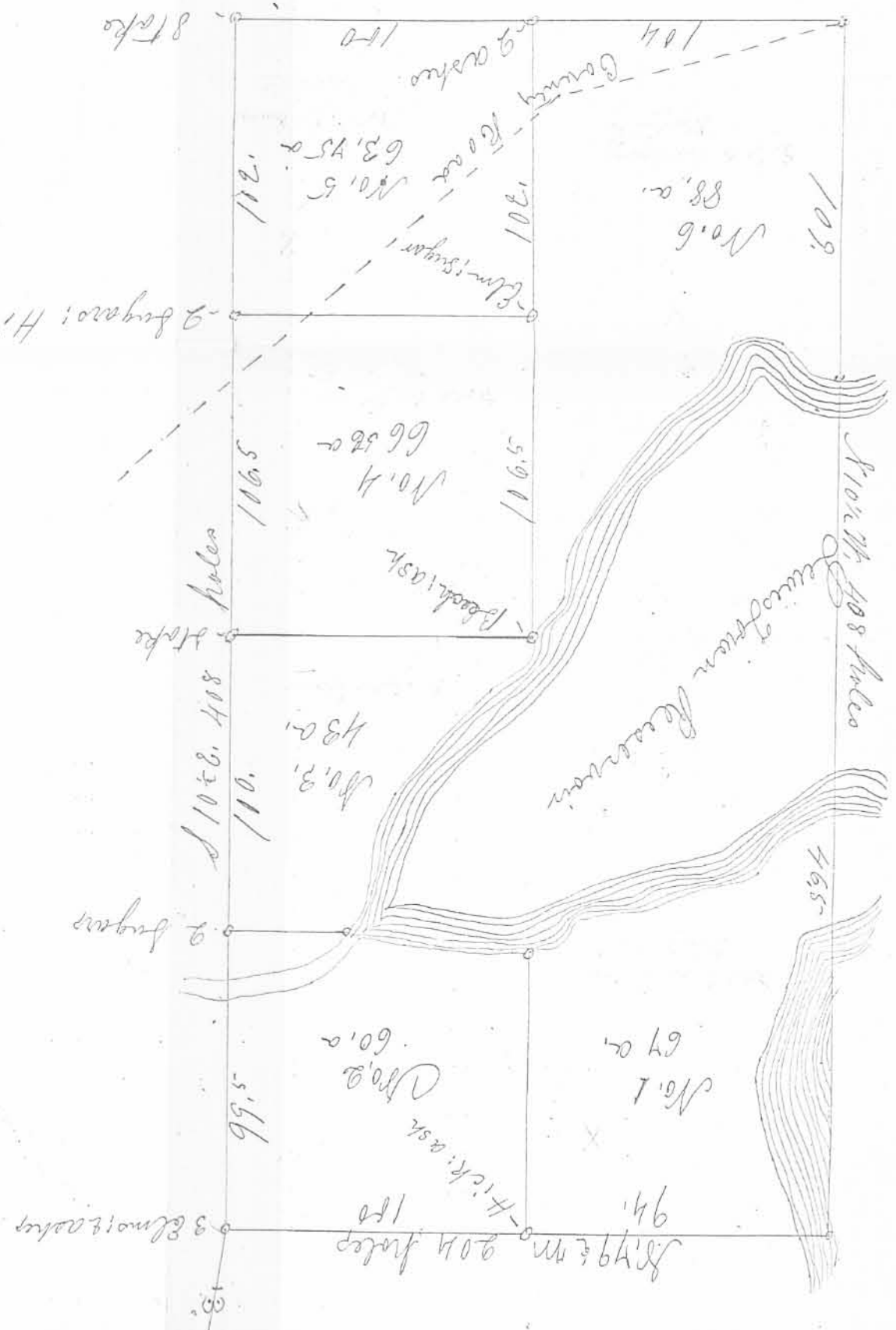

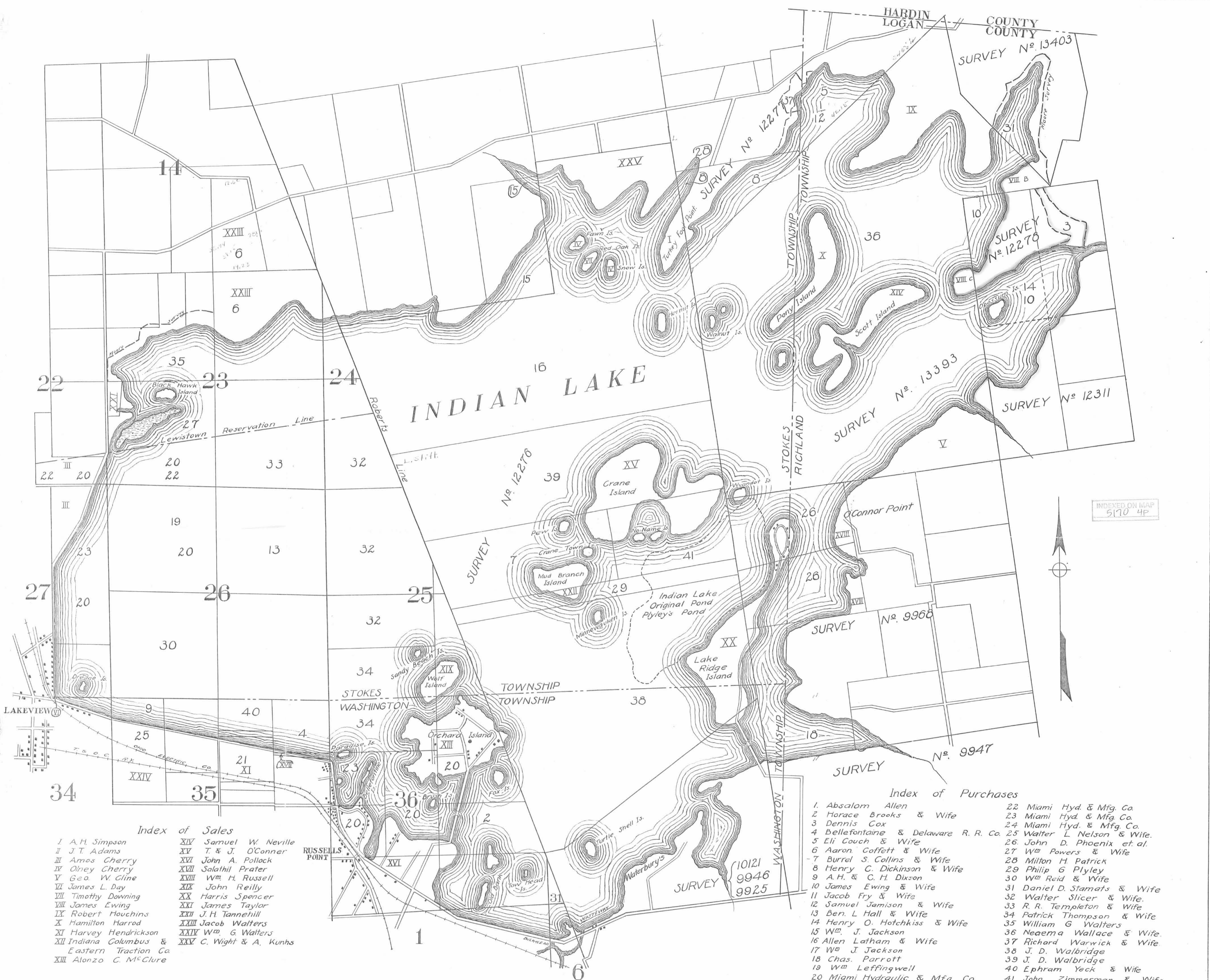
