of said Prater tract N. 88° - $58'$ E. 458.65 feet to an iron pipe at the
N.W. corner of E.H.Shaw's 122.52 acre tract thence with the west side of
said Shaw land S. 1° - $26'$ E. 379.50 feet to an iron pipe thence
S. 88° - $58'$ W. 689.15 feet to the center of State Highway Number 226
