**Survey for Jaila Kruse
1.500 acres
November 21, 1995**

The following described tract of land is situated in the State of Ohio, County of Logan, Township of Rushcreek, V.M.S. 3320, being part of Robert F. Provo's original 9.924 acre tract described in official record 271, page 590, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning for reference at a ½" iron pipe found at the intersection of the centerline of County Road #25 (C.R.#25) (50 feet wide) with the south line of V.M.S. 3320, said pipe marking the southwest corner of David E. And Jaila I. Kruse's 0.256 acre tract described in official record 156, page 326;

thence North 08°55'00" West (assumed bearing) 93.20 feet, following the centerline of C.R.#25 and the west line of said 0.256 acre tract, to a railroad spike found at the northwest corner of said 0.256 acre tract and in the west line of said 9.924 acre tract, said spike marking the place of beginning;

thence North 08°55'00" West 38.39 feet, continuing along the centerline of C.R. #25 and the west line of said 9.924 acre tract, to a railroad spike set;

thence North 86°59'55" East 588.38 feet, departing from the centerline of C.R.#25, entering said 9.924 acre tract, passing at 25.06 feet an iron pin set, to an iron pin set in the east line of said 9.924 acre tract and in the west of the Central Conference Church of United Brethren Christ's 138.71 acre tract described in official record 73, page 984;

thence South 07°04'53" East 131.22 feet, following the east line of said 9.924 acre tract and the west line of said 138.71 acre tract, to a ½" iron pipe found at the northeast corner of David E. And Jaila I. Kruse's 2.44 acre tract described in official record 156, page 326, said pipe being in the south line of V.M.S. 3320 and the north line of V.M.S. 3441;


thence South 86°59'55" West 446.07 feet, following the south line of V.M.S. 3320, the north line of V.M.S. 3441, the south line of said 9.924 acre tract and the north line of said 2.44 acre tract, to a ½" iron pipe found at the southeast corner of said 0.256 acre tract;

thence North 34°48'20" West 130.37 feet, following the east line of said 0.256 acre tract and the west line of said 9.924 acre tract, to a ½" iron pipe found;

thence South 74°05'38" West 81.03 feet, following the north line of said 0.256 acre tract and the south line of said 9.924 acre tract, passing at 55.89 feet a ½" iron pipe found, to the place of beginning, containing 1.500 acres, more or less, and subject to all valid easements and restrictions of record, with 0.020 acre within the road right of way.

The above description was prepared from an actual field survey made under the supervision of Paul R. Clapsaddle, Registered Surveyor #6140 during the month of November, 1995. Iron pins set are 5/8" by 30" reinforcing rods with caps marked "CLAPSADDLE R.S. #6140." Bearings indicated hereon are based on an assumed meridian and are to denote angles only.

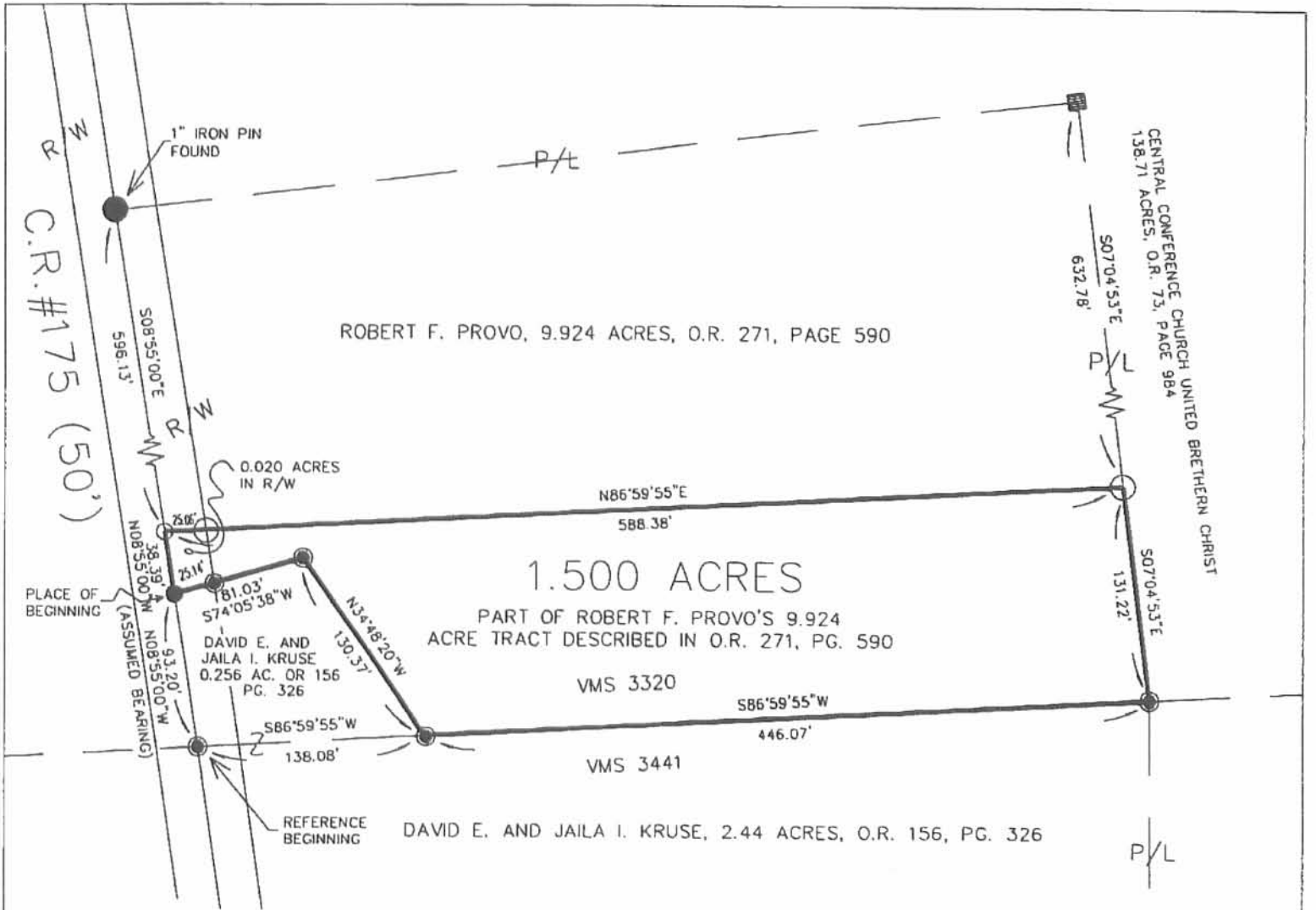

Stakes for fence - F.M. Shoals Farm

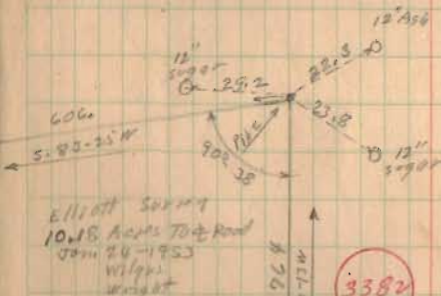
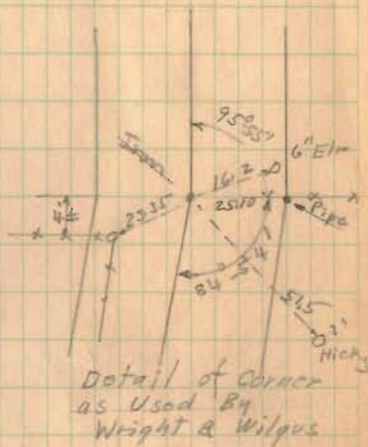
