Beginning at a stake at the intersection of the North side of Columbus St. (Columbus St. being 60 feet wide) and the East side of Sandusky St. (Sandusky St. being 60 feet wide) said stake being also the S.W. corner of Original Lot #13; thence North with the East side of Sandusky St. 54 feet to a point; thence East passing along the North side of a brick house (and also following a fence) 160 feet to a point in the South side of Cherry Alley; thence South along the ~~west~~ side of Cherry Alley 29.75 feet to a stake, said stake being the S.E. corner of Original Lot #13, thence with the North side of Columbus St. to the place of beginning.

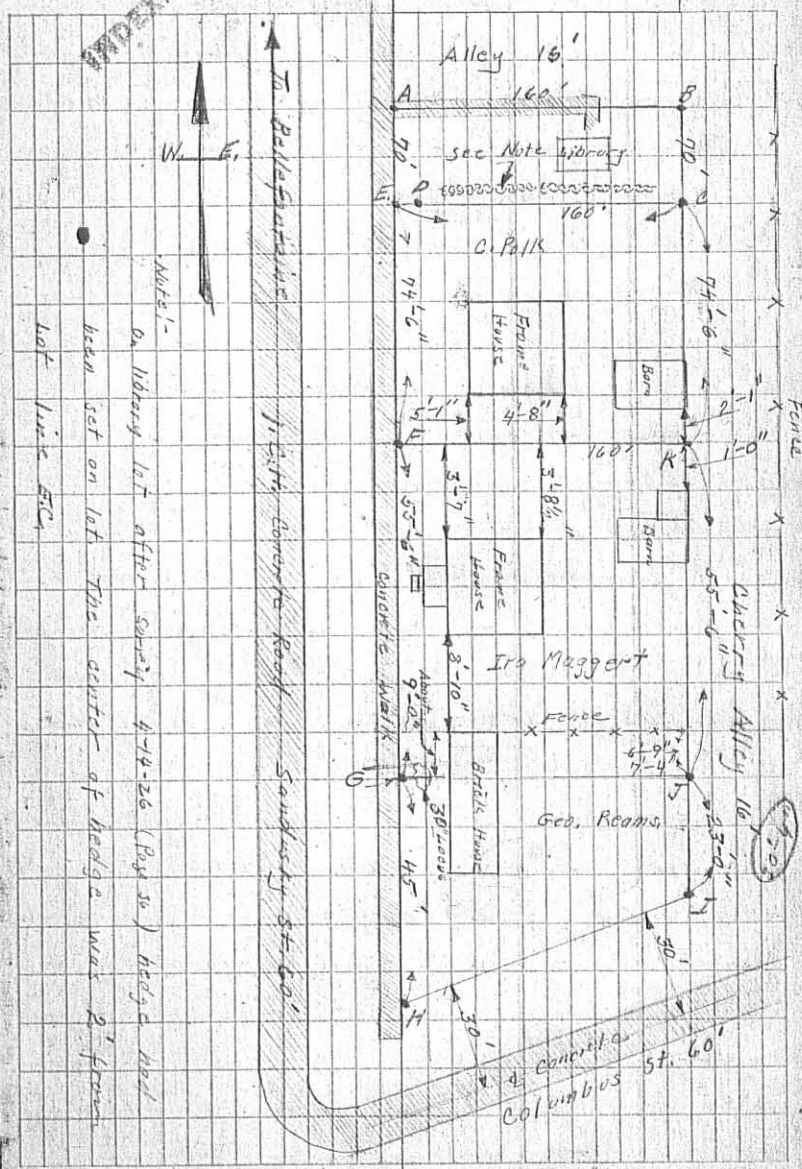

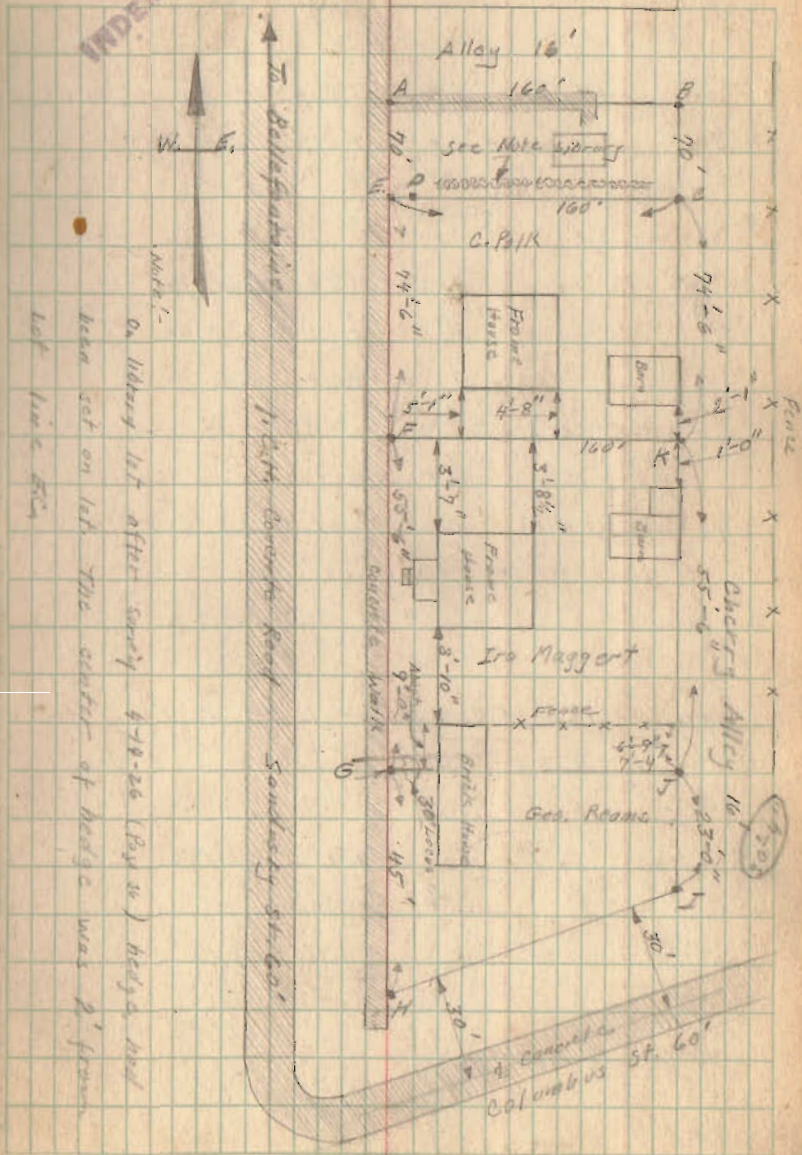
