

Thence South 88°53'19" East (assumed bearing) 32.57 feet, following the centerline of Bristle Ridge Road, to a point;

Thence North 12°09'46" East 112.64 feet, crossing Bristle Ridge Road and passing at 21.16 feet a 1 inch iron pipe found at the southwest corner of Lance A.
